


The college keeps an institutional-level feedback report. Feedback is gathered from a variety of stakeholders, including students, teachers, parents, employers, and graduates.

Analysis of feedback received from alumni of BCA department during the annual alumni meet.






It was encouraging to see that the majority of parents gave the highest ratings possible for all teaching and non-teaching factors.

The course syllabus has good balance between theory and application.





### Action Taken Report on Feedback 2019-2020

#### 1. Feedback Collection Process from the Stakeholders

The college maintains an institutional level feedback report. Feedback is collected from different stakeholders like students, teachers, parents, employers and alumni.

Parents' opinions are solicited at PTA meetings, alumni's opinions are gathered at the departmental and yearly alumni gatherings, all students' opinions are gathered at the conclusion of each semester regarding the curriculum and its delivery, and teachers' opinions are also solicited. Additionally, a student survey is gathered as part of the course outcome evaluation for each course. The information gathered is used to assess the success of the curriculum, how it is delivered, as well as other factors like infrastructure, extracurricular activities, and similar things. These criteria include evaluating the course's breadth, coverage, learning objectives, clarity, and relevancy.

#### 2. Feedback Analysis

For the purpose of creating the analysis report, the collected feedback is sorted and aggregated. The data entered in the chosen format is transformed into a chart and decoded for the correct understanding of the subject. At the departmental and institutional levels, the issues raised by the stakeholders are discussed. The ideas submitted regarding the curriculum are used as guides for identifying its holes and subsequently filling them. The recommendations are reviewed and evaluated. To guarantee that the complaints are resolved properly, appropriate suggestions are developed

#### 3. Action Taken Report

The ideas gathered from the comments are swiftly debated in various committees and distributed to the faculty so they may devise new ways to increase the efficiency of material delivery. Since the institution is an affiliated college, it must adhere to the university's curriculum. The delivery of the curriculum is therefore prioritised over its revision. However, the college's value-added courses and its organisation of talks, seminars, and other events under the auspices of various departments, groups, and clubs fill any holes in the university's curriculum that stakeholders have identified
