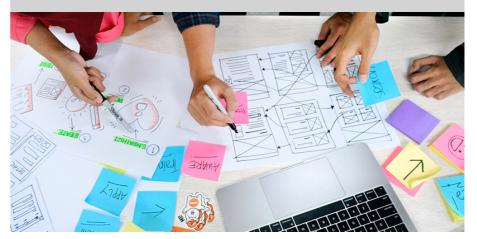
1. Capstone Project
