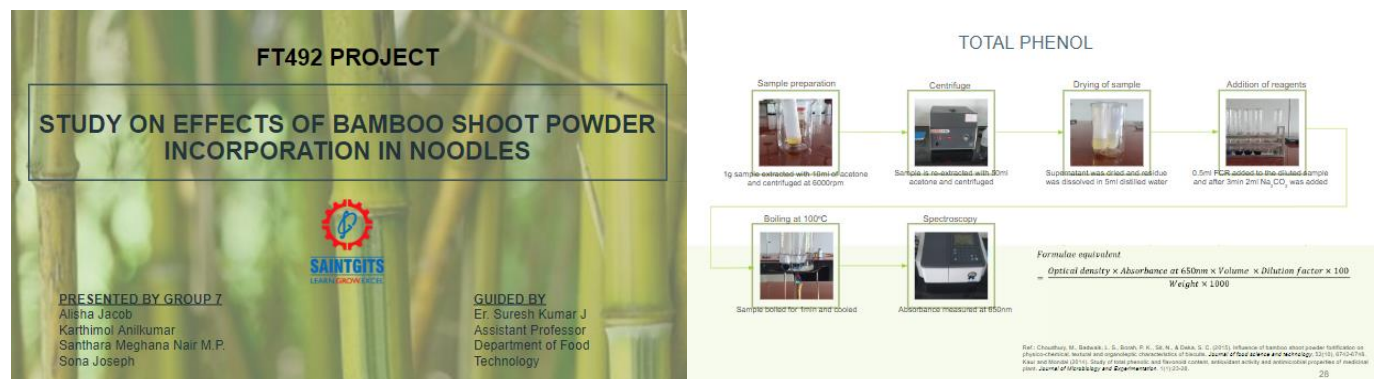

Dr. Girilal M and Er. Daniel Paul P, of Food Technology department coordinated the event.

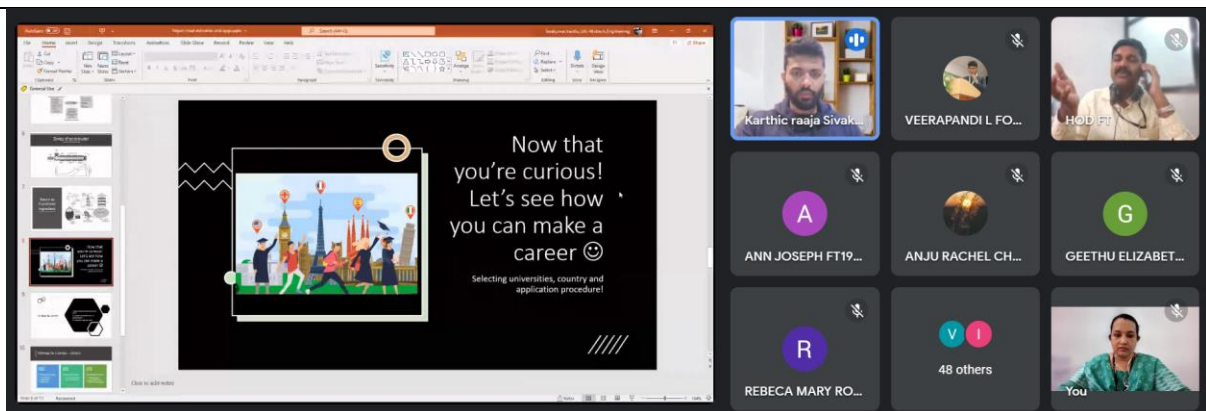

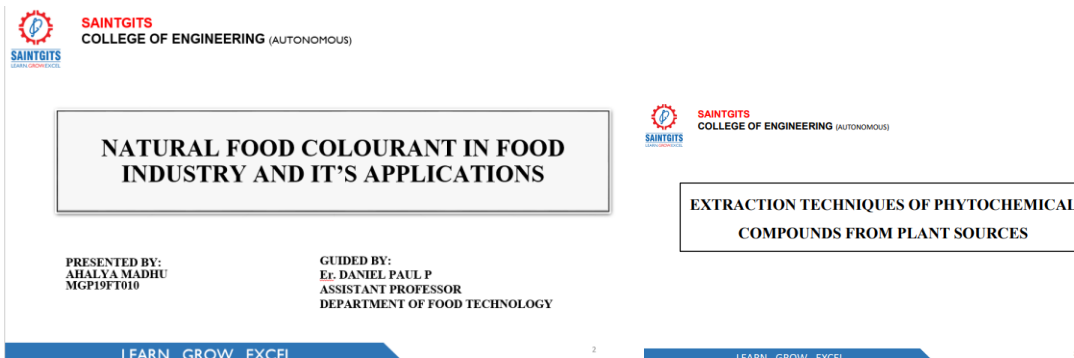


Report
