Life Skill Club: Fresh from Scrap



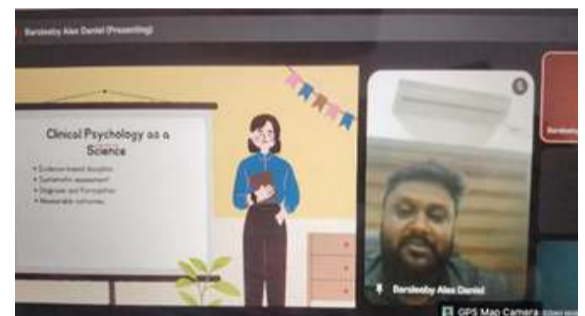

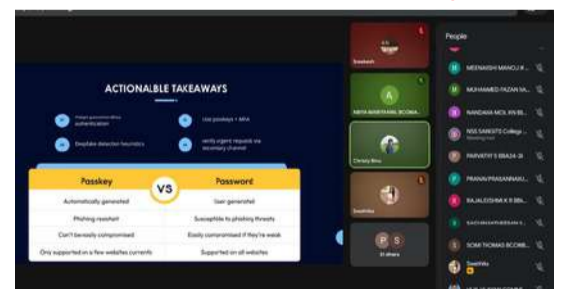
Music and Dance Club: Campus Rhythms
